

DAAD Language Certificate at ZSIK

The DAAD Language Certificate is for students who need to demonstrate their level of English language ability for:

- study abroad
- internships
- projects
- job applications etc.

DAAD Language Certificate – with test

The DAAD test is based on the IELTS language testing system: academic reading (online), academic writing (online) and speaking. The speaking test will take place by arrangement either face-to-face or on Zoom – participants will be contacted.

The DAAD test is offered four times per year:

- one week before and for one week after the start of each semester
- each IdW session.

Dates will be posted on the ZSIK website under 'Aktuelles'.

Certificates will be issued once all tests have been assessed and will be available to collect from the ZSIK Service Büro (C19 – 0.32).

DAAD Language Certificate – without test*

Students who have successfully completed an English module at ZSIK, or at another higher education institute, may be able to receive a DAAD Language Certificate without testing: see point iv) below.

- iv) *to obtain a DAAD Language Certificate without a test the above and proof of completion is required – e.g. QIS, Transcript of Records etc..
